So far, we have collected enough to provide 34 nets for the Malaria project.

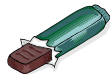

## What's Happening in 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>



Welcome back to a new year! We ended the year by eating fried worms before our Christmas party and everyone survived! 😊

**Math** most fourth graders are working on graphing or possible outcomes. Third graders are all individualized and working on subtraction of numbers that are smaller than the lower number. **Language Arts** Next week we will have spelling tests. We just finished this week learning about poems and creating our own. Come see their work in the classroom of their poems! **Science**— There will be an open note test next week Wednesday or Thursday. A study guide has been sent home! I encourage them to do the study guide as they may have the opportunity to use it for their test. **Social Studies:** Chapter 2 *Understanding Regions*. Each student is in a group and their group is creating a business! They are choosing what they want to sell based on their regional location. We are combining social studies as well as working on our math skills. This business project is their chapter assessment as well! They will be "selling" objects to other students in the school. (Ask your daughter about their business). **Religion: God the Father's Gracious Gifts.** We will start nuggets for memory work as well as one verse per week. More info on nuggets at a later time.

**Reminder:** It is starting to get colder outside and snow-covered playground. If your child does not want to stay on the pavement all recess be sure to send snow pants and boots!

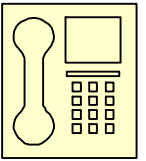
