


EPISTLE ~ 1 John 3:1–3



Sabaoth (SAH-bay-oath) is Hebrew for "heavenly hosts." Hosanna is a Hebrew word of praise meaning "save us now."


 → body, which is given for you. This do in remembrance of Me."




