- C Amen.




#### SERVICE OF THE WORD







#### **SALUTATION and COLLECT OF THE DAY**


#### HOLY GOSPEL ~ Luke 17:11-19

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.


And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord,
