HEALTH KIT ITEMS NEEDED:

1 dark colored bath towel (between 20 x 40 and 52 x 27)

27 adult size tooth brushes in original wrappers

SCHOOL KIT ITEMS NEEDED:

327 - 70 sheet spiral notebooks of wide or college ruled paper

77 - 30 centimeter rulers or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other

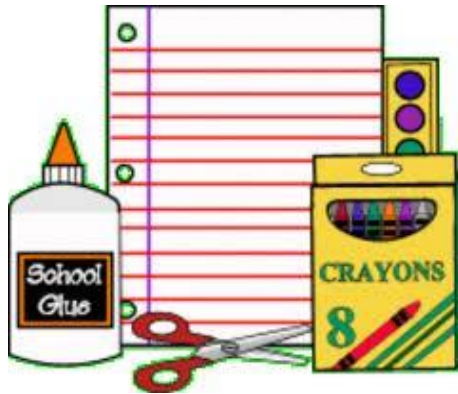
76 pencil sharpeners (1 pencil)
