

The Season of Lent

What is the significance of Lent?

Early in the Church's history, the major events in Christ's life were observed with special observances, such as His birth, baptism, death, resurrection, and ascension.

As these observances developed, a period of time was set aside prior to the major events of Jesus' birth and resurrection as a time of preparation.

During Lent, the Church's worship assumes a more penitential character. The color for the season is purple, a color often associated with penitence. The "Hymn of Praise" is omitted from the liturgy. The word "Alleluia" is usually omitted as well.

By not using the alleluia — a joyful expression meaning "Praise the Lord" — until Easter, the Lenten season is clearly set apart as a distinct time from the rest of the year.

Additionally, it forms a powerful contrast with the festive celebration of Jesus' resurrection when our alleluias ring loud and clear.

Finally, the penitential character of Lent is not its sole purpose. In the ancient Church, the weeks leading up to Easter were a time of intensive preparation of the candidates who were to be baptized at the Easter vigil on Holy Saturday.

This time in the Church's calendar was seen as an especially appropriate time for Baptism because of the relationship between Christ's death and resurrection and our own in Holy Baptism (see Rom. 6:1-11).

This focus would suggest that the season of Lent serves not only as a time to meditate on the suffering that Christ endured on our behalf but also as an opportunity to reflect upon our own-Baptism-and what it means to live as a child of God.




Altar Guild Help Needed

Catechetical Comments

A Series

THE APOSTLES' CREED

This month we continue our consideration of the First Article of the Apostles' Creed, with special focus on question 103.

103. How did God first create life?

God created all living things, both plant and animal, by His Word alone, from nothing. He created humanity specially, from dust, then gave us His own breath as life.

Martin Luther continues his explanation of the First Article of the Creed by asking the question:

How did God first create life?

He answers this question with the statement:

God created all living things, both plant and animal, by His Word alone, from nothing. He created humanity specially, from dust, then gave us His own breath as life.

For scriptural support of this statement, he provides the following:

Genesis 2:7 – The LORD God formed the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living creature.

Psalm 139:14 – I praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are Your works; my soul knows it very well.

The first chapter of Genesis says that God "spoke" and whatever He spoke happened. Immediately. The first day He made light. The second day He made the earth and sky. The third day He made land masses on the earth

and caused plants and trees, etc., to come forth out of the ground. On the fourth day, He created the sun, moon, and stars, and so on. These were normal 24-hour days. We know this for a number of reasons, not the least of which is the mention of evening and a morning for each day. Besides, why would God use a word that means something other than what it means? The Hebrew word *yom* means a day. It's as simple as that.

These were not epochs of time, this is not figurative speech; it's historical narrative. Nor did God "use" evolution or some quantum singularity in His work of creation. Psalm 33:6 says, "By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, and by the breath of his mouth all their host." With the singular exception in which God created man by molding him by hand, God spoke and everything came to be. I know this doesn't jibe with evolutionary theory. I don't care! God's Word trumps the evolutionists. I know this may come as a shock, but the evolutionists are WRONG!

This ought to be wonderful news! You are not an accident of nature. God created you on purpose. You were made by the God who loves you, not by some accident of physics over billions of years. God molded Adam so that He could be personally involved in his creation. He made you, using the intimacy of love, so that you could be personally connected to Him.

We are fearfully and wonderfully made by the God of the universe, the Creator, and He still breathes into each of us His breath of life. Thanks be to God! +



February Stewardship Talk - Pastors' Appeal Update

Hello! On behalf of our Pastors, we would like to give you an update on the 2024-25 Pastors' Appeal. As of last weekend, the total offerings are \$117,500. We are on our way to the next plateau of \$150,000. Thanks be to our God!

While this is a great blessing, the sobering reality is that we have already needed to pull \$67,500 out of this \$117,500 total in order to meet current expenses. And this does not include paying anything back on the \$81,500 that we previously borrowed from our restricted funds. Is this a concern? YES!

With that in mind, let's take a moment to think about the original plan for the Pastors' Appeal. If you recall, Pastor Billings' presentation at our kickoff event talked about the ongoing nature of giving regularly over and above our weekly or monthly tithes and offerings. And, for good reason!
