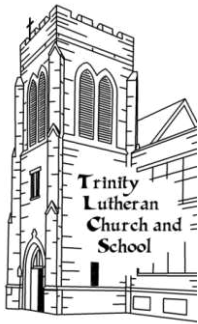

# Catechetical Comments

A Series

## THE APOSTLES' CREED

This month we return to our consideration of the First Article of the Apostles' Creed by taking up question 105.

*105. What is the Christian's proper response to theories of evolution regarding the beginning of the world?*

By faith Christians believe what the Word of God teaches about creation. Evolutionary theories are not scientifically verifiable.

The *Catechism* continues its explanation of the First Article of the Creed by asking the question:

*What is the Christian's proper response to theories of evolution regarding the beginning of the world?*

It answers by saying:

*By faith Christians believe what the Word of God teaches about creation. Evolutionary theories are not scientifically verifiable.*

For scriptural support of these statements, the following passages are provided:

**Hebrews 11:3** – By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.

**2 Peter 3:5-6** – They deliberately overlook this fact, that the heavens existed long ago, and the earth was formed out of water and through water by the word of God, and that by means of these the world that then existed was deluged with water and perished.

**1 Timothy 6:20-21** – Guard the deposit entrusted to you. Avoid the irreverent babble and contradictions of what is falsely called “knowledge,” for by professing it some have swerved from the faith.

Any regular reader of this column will by now know the position of the Church on the theory of evolution. The Bible says very clearly that the universe was created by the Word of God, as the writer to the Hebrews says. We could easily add to that Psalm 33:6 – “By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, and by the breath of his mouth all their host.”

Peter points out (2 Pet. 3:5-6) that the creation itself testifies to the existence of a creator, even eluding to a global flood.

The notion (in all its forms) that the universe evolved over billions of years and gradually became more and more complex is not scientifically demonstrable; in fact, it contradicts well established scientific principles, such as the Second Law of Thermal Dynamics, known as Entropy, which is the concept that energy gradually spreads out and the process cannot be reversed. In other words, energy becomes more disperse over time. Evolutionary theory insists on the opposite. Evolutionary theory is bad science because it is not very scientific, making statements about the origin of the universe that it cannot prove. This kind of thinking (“contradictions of what is called ‘knowledge’”) is what Paul encouraged Timothy to avoid. We should avoid it, too. Stick to what is demonstrably true from God's revelation, both natural (science) and special (His divine Word). †

## Stewardship Message

Has fundraising taken away our focus on the importance regarding regular giving to our Ministry budget?

We do seem to have a great multitude of fundraising events at Trinity and though each event is necessary and used to further God's mission for our church and school, the fundraisers may interfere with regular giving.

However, our Mission budget is also of great importance since this budget supports our staff, building and maintenance as well as outreach to those that do not yet know their Lord and Savior. Unfortunately, we can lose our focus on the Ministry fund because it tends to get lost in the promotional efforts by the fundraising committees. It's sort of like the phrase, "the squeaky wheel gets the grease."

Although both fundraising and regular giving are both needed, the Ministry Fund should be the priority in first fruits giving. This statement is not meant in any way to discredit fundraising efforts, it is intended to refocus this congregation on regular **sustained** giving and, at this point in time, **increased** giving.

You have heard many pleas for increasing regular giving. We've attempted to keep each member in the loop regarding the financial situation at Trinity and have been as transparent as possible in sharing information. It is a fact that our weekly offerings do not cover our expenses. Our Ministry Fund continues to fall short, and our deficit continues to grow at approximately \$4000 per week. Yes, \$4000 per week and unfortunately this figure continues to grow.

The budget that was adopted by the Congregation last July was a bare bones, no fat added budget. There isn't anything in that budget that is not needed to keep Trinity going.

It is not, by any means, easy or pleasant to ask you to increase your giving but it is our job to keep you aware of the circumstances surrounding our financial situation, to allow you to make informed decisions regarding your personal giving.

This situation needs your attention, this is about every single member finding a way to provide income for our mission budget. When you think about how \$132, 000 was raised by Pastor's appeal and \$70,000 raised for windows you realize that additional funding will come in when we are focused on God's will for Trinity **and that**, brothers and sisters, is our Ministry Fund (formerly called our General Fund). Be aware, pray hard and pay attention to what is happening at Trinity. Pray for God's guidance in your personal budget process, ask Him to show you how to give sacrificially, and pray that He will supply all that we need.

Thank you. Blessings on your deliberations.

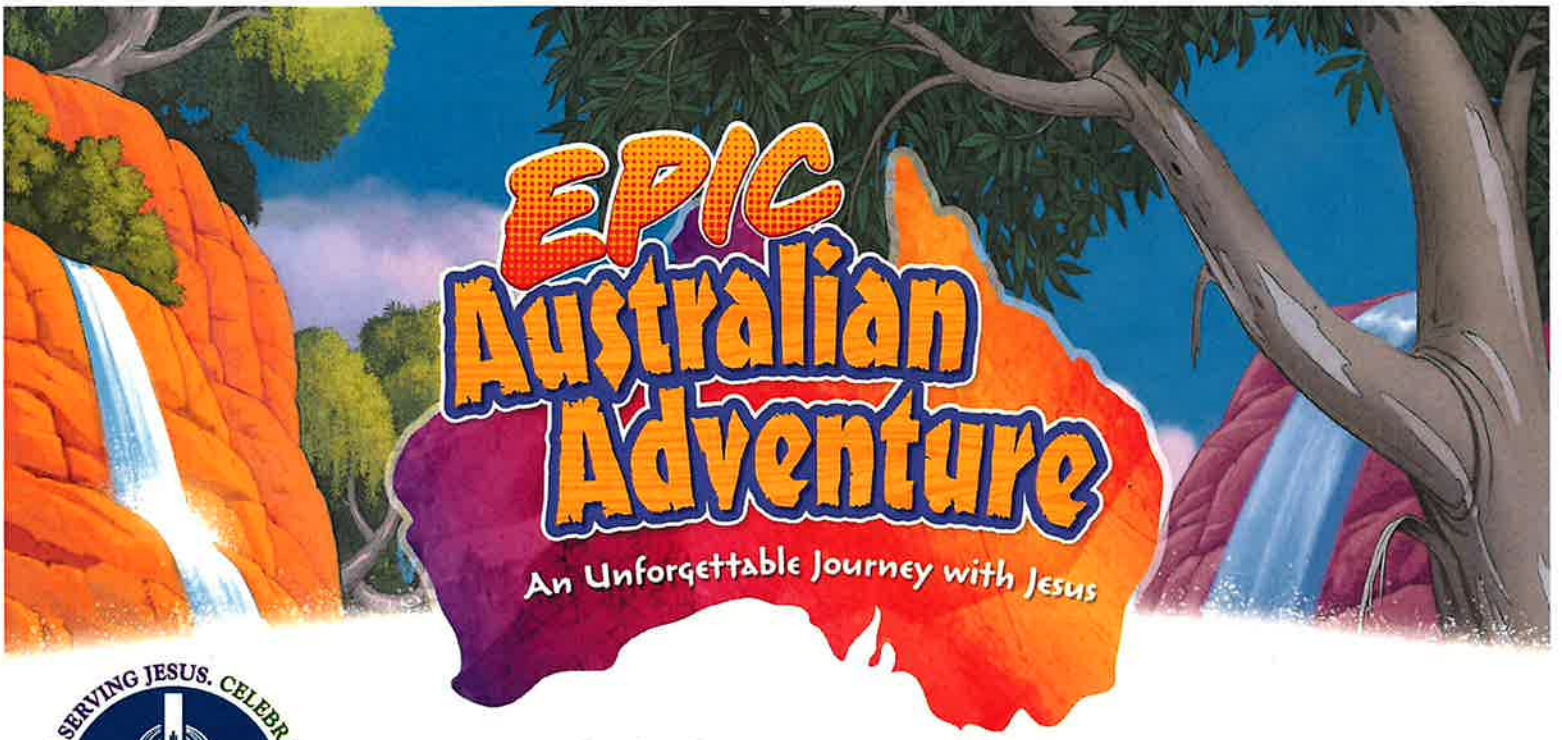
